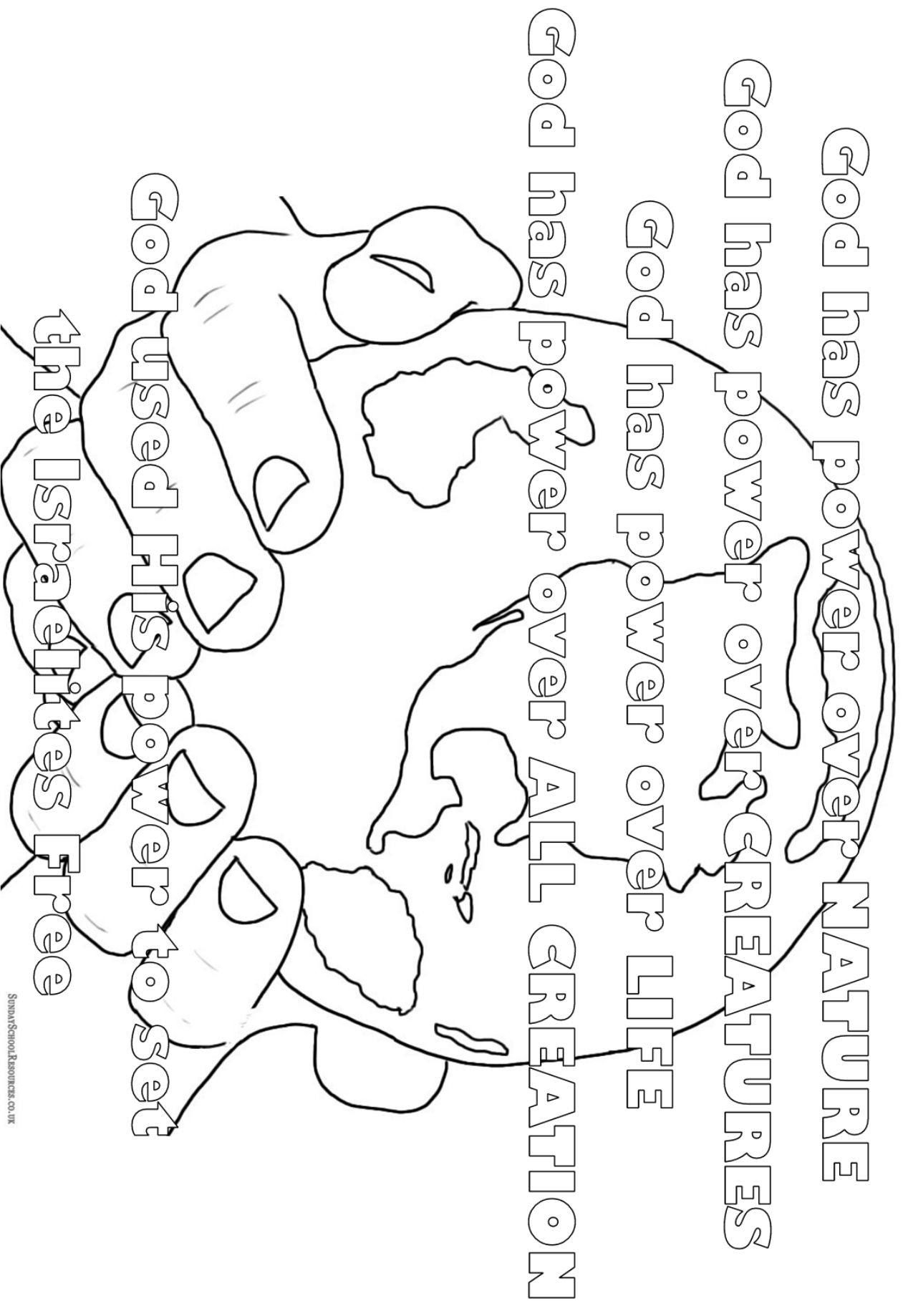
Introduce Bible Story

Exodus 7-11 – God demonstrates His **power** over all creation to free the Israelites from captivity

- Why were the people in Egypt?
 - Who did God choose to lead the people out of Egypt?
 - How did Pharaoh feel about letting the Israelites go?
 - How did God change His mind?
1. **7:14-24 – Turned the Nile to blood**
 - a. V. 18 "The fish will die. The river will stink. The Egyptians will not be able to drink its water"
 2. **7:25-8:15 – A plague of frogs**
 - a. V. 3-4 "The Nile River will be full of frogs. They will come up into your palace. You will have frogs in your bedroom and on your bed. They will be in the homes of your officials and your people. They will be in your ovens and in the bowls for kneading your bread. 4 The frogs will be on you, your people and all your officials."
 3. **8:16-19 – A plague of gnats** - The dust all over the land of Egypt turned into gnats
 4. **8:20-32 – A plague of flies** – All over Egypt flies destroyed the land
 5. **9:1-7 – A plague of dead livestock** - I will strike your horses, donkeys, camels, cattle, sheep and goats.
 6. **9:8-12 – A Plague of boils** - Then painful boils will break out on people and animals all over the land. Their bodies will be covered with them.
 7. **9:13-25 – A plague of hail** – v25 - Hail struck everything in the fields all over Egypt. It fell on people and animals alike. It beat down everything growing in the fields. It tore all the leaves off the trees
 8. **10:1-20 – A plague of locusts**
 - a. V. 5-6 - They will cover the ground so that it can't be seen. They will eat what little you have left after the hail. That includes every tree growing in your fields. They will fill your houses. They will be in the homes of all your officials and your people.
 9. **10:21-29 – Total darkness for 3 days** - v. 23 - No one could see anyone else or go anywhere for three days. But all the people of Israel had light where they lived.
 10. **11:1 – 12:30 – Death of the firstborn**

PlagueBall

Materials:

- 3 baskets or buckets with one labeled **nature**, one labeled **creatures**, and one labeled **life**
- 10 small plastic balls; one labeled for each of the plagues
 - Blood, hail, darkness, frogs, gnats, flies, locusts, livestock, boils, firstborn

Directions:

- Divide students into 2 teams
- Allow students to take turns tossing one of the balls into the “basket” that matches its category
 - Blood, hail, darkness → Nature
 - Frogs, gnats, flies, locusts → Creatures
 - Livestock, boils, firstborn → Life
- Award points for every ball that is tossed into the correct “basket”

World in his hands craft



Materials

- Round, white, paper plate for each student (optional for added support)
- White or beige cardstock; 1 sheet per student
- One copy per student of the earth outline on the following page
- Blue, green, and brown markers, paint, or crayons
- Other colors if students want to color the hands
- One pencil per student, or enough to share

Directions:

- Color and cut out the earth outline on the following page
- If using paper plates, glue the earth outline to the plate
- Have students trace both of their hands onto a sheet of cardstock
- Cut out hands
- Position the behind the plate toward the bottom with thumbs facing out and fingers facing down
- Fold fingers up so that the hand appears to hold the earth
- Glue hands in place

Introduce Bible Story

Exodus 13:17-21 – God guides the Israelites by His **presence**

Pharaoh let the people go. The shortest road from Goshen to Canaan went through the Philistine country. But God didn't lead them that way. God said, "If they have to go into battle, they might change their minds. They might return to Egypt." So God led the people toward the Red Sea by taking them on a road through the desert. The Israelites were ready for battle when they went up out of Egypt.

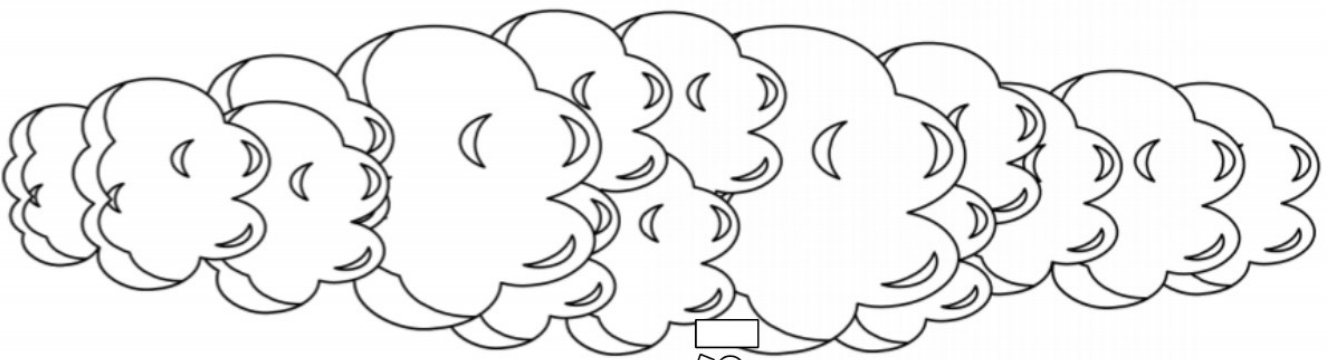
Moses took the bones of Joseph along with him. Joseph had made the Israelites give their word to do this. He had said, "God will surely come to help you. When he does, you must carry my bones up from this place with you." (*Genesis 50:25*)

The people left Sukkoth. They camped at Etham on the edge of the desert. By day the Lord went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud. It guided them on their way. At night he led them with a pillar of fire. It gave them light. So they could travel by day or at night. The pillar of cloud didn't leave its place in front of the people during the day. And the pillar of fire didn't leave its place at night.

(NIRV)

Discuss Points

- God showed the Israelites where to go
 - God guided them on their way
- God was always with His people
 - Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people. (v22, NIV)

Follow the Leader

Materials:

- Small pillow or other object to represent a cloud
- Glow stick or flash light (for dark option)

Directions:

- Choose a person to be the leader and give them the “cloud” (or light if using dark option)
- All other students should stand in a line behind the leader
- Explain that when the leader holds up the cloud or the light, they should all follow, in line, wherever the leader goes. When the leader puts the object back down everyone should stop.
- Anyone who does not stop will sit out until the next round
- The last person standing gets to be the next leader

Pillar of Cloud and Fire



Materials

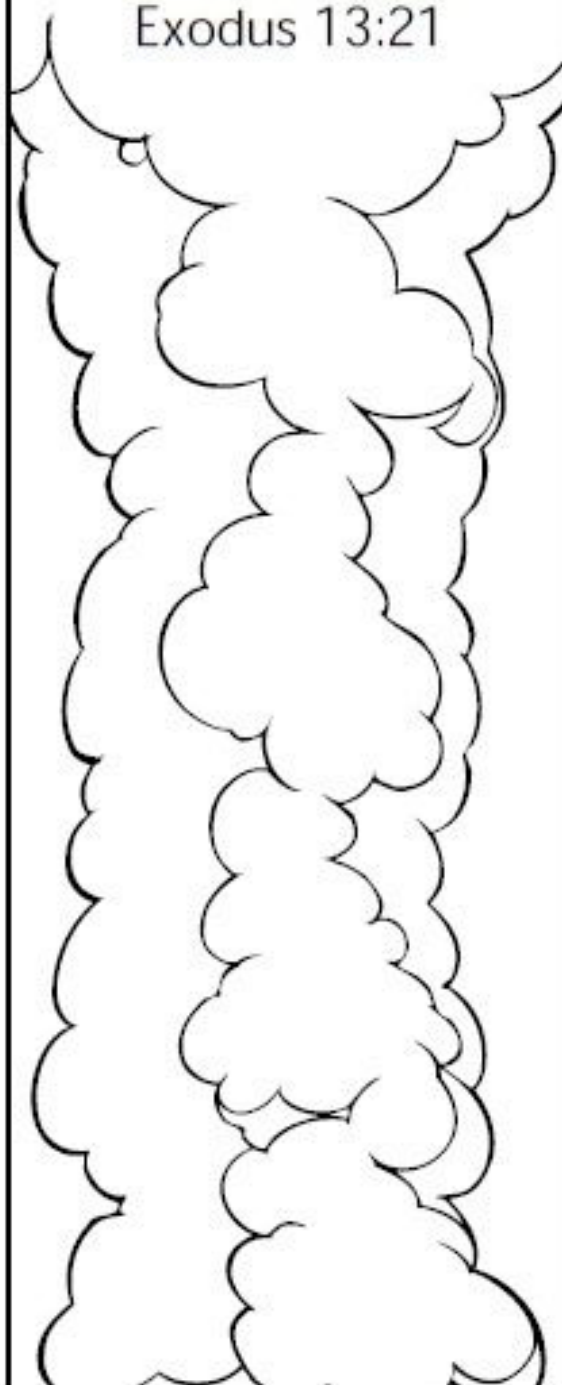
- Either of the following
 - Option 1:
 - One copy of the cloud and fire sheet for each student
 - Crayons or markers
 - Option 2:
 - Small squares of red, yellow, and orange tissue paper (3-4 in' squares)
 - 10 to 15 cotton balls per student
- One large craft stick OR empty toilet paper roll per student
- Glue

Directions

- If using the coloring sheet option begin by having the students color and cut out both sides. If not using the coloring sheet, the Bible reference "Exodus 13:21" may be written on one end of the craft stick or toilet paper roll.
- On one face of the craft stick or toilet paper roll glue the pillar of fire coloring sheet or glue the pieces of yellow, orange, and red tissue paper to resemble fire. (Arranging in that order with yellow on the inside/bottom and red on the outside/top should produce the best result)
- On the opposite face glue cotton balls to form a pillar of cloud

Introduce Bible Story

Exodus 14:10-31 – God **protects** the Israelites from their enemies

The following excerpt is an abridged version of the NIV/NirV translations:

Pharaoh changed his mind about letting the Israelites go and decided to chase them and bring them back to Egypt.

As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites... were terrified and cried out to the Lord. They said to Moses..., "It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!"

Moses answered the people. He said, "Don't be afraid. Stand firm. You will see how the Lord will save you today. Do you see those Egyptians? You will never see them again. The Lord will fight for you. Just be still."

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? Tell the Israelites to move on. Raise your staff and stretch out your hand over the sea to divide the water so that the Israelites can go through the sea on dry ground. I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians so that they will go in after them. And I will gain glory through Pharaoh and all his army, through his chariots and his horsemen. The Egyptians will know that I am the Lord when I gain glory through Pharaoh, his chariots and his horsemen..."

Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and all that night the Lord drove the sea back with a strong east wind and turned it into dry land. The waters were divided, and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left.

The Egyptians pursued them, and all Pharaoh's horses and chariots and horsemen followed them into the sea. During the last watch of the night the Lord looked down from the pillar of fire and cloud at the Egyptian army and threw it into confusion. He jammed the wheels of their chariots so that they had difficulty driving. And the Egyptians said, "Let's get away from the Israelites! The Lord is fighting for them against Egypt."

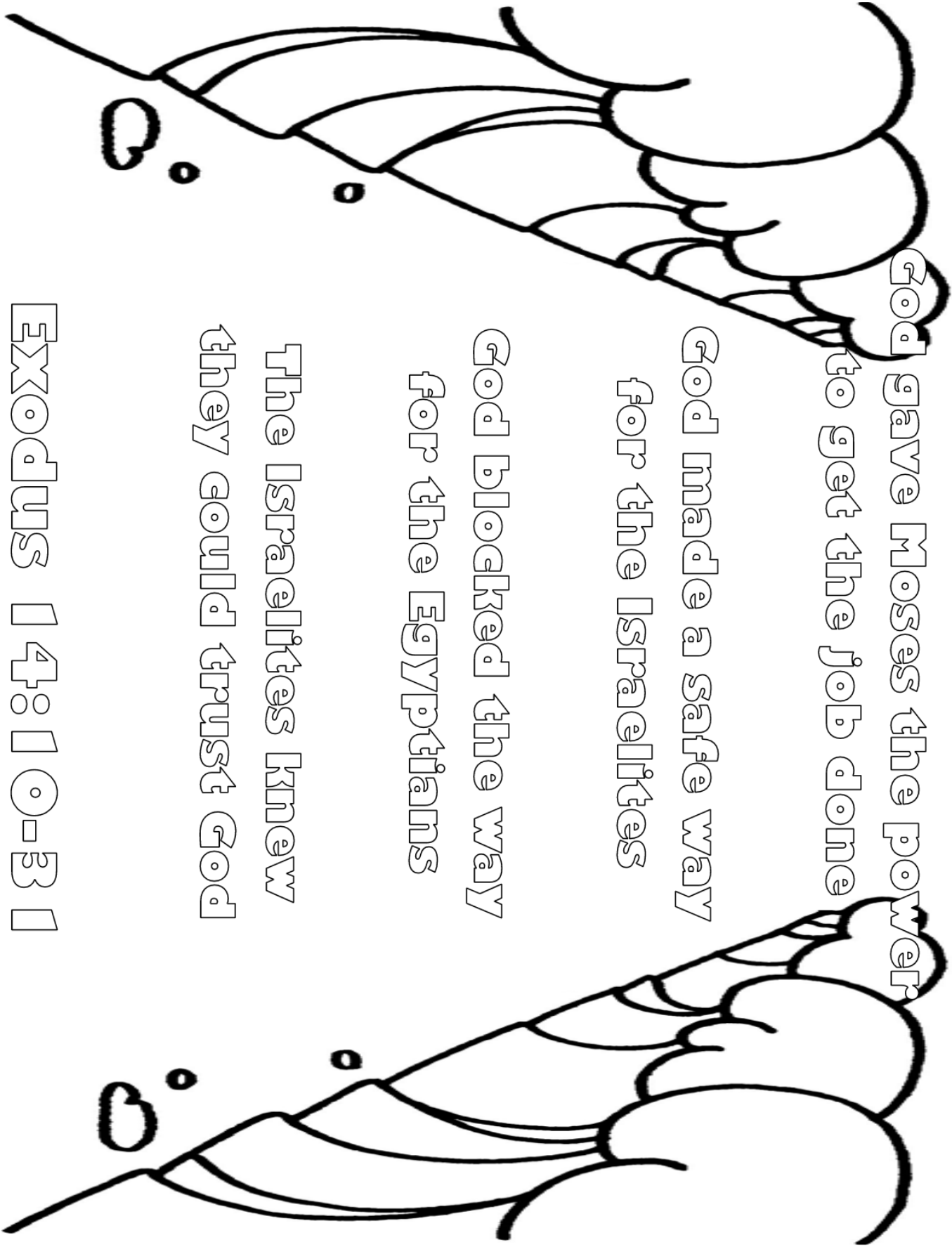
Then the Lord said to Moses, "Stretch out your hand over the sea so that the waters may flow back over the Egyptians and their chariots and horsemen." Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and at daybreak the sea went back to its place. The Egyptians were fleeing toward it, and the Lord swept them into the sea. The water flowed back and covered the chariots and

horsemen—the entire army of Pharaoh that had followed the Israelites into the sea. Not one of them survived.

But the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left. That day the Lord saved Israel from the hands of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians lying dead on the shore. And when the Israelites saw the mighty hand of the Lord displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the Lord and put their trust in him and in Moses his servant.

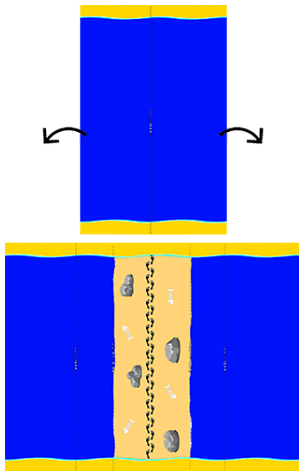
